WHAT IS REQUIRED OF YOU?

- * Protections of nature or animals
- * The faith journey of children or adults
- * Marquette special projects approved for all students

WHAT DOES NOT COUNT:

- Janitorial work at MCHS
- Babysitting
- Yard work for neighbors/parents/grandparents
- Work for the Development Office (unless specifically announced)
- Office work for your parents (unless they work fits one of the above categories)

REMEMBER: Document all of your service...Anyone over 100 hours may be eligible for the Presidential Service Award.
