Senior Mission Trip

At this time, another senior mission trip is being planned. All efforts for planning this trip (senior meetings and fundraising) as well as actively participating during the trip will satisfy the senior requirements for the Service Learning Program. Completion of the prayer journal during the trip will satisfy the senior retreat requirement.

Seniors not making the trip will be placed into service projects in your hometown or in the Alton/Godfrey area. Seniors will work with the Campus Minister to find a satisfactory placement. Service projects will coincide with the mission trip and take at least 6 hours of work per day. A prayer journal will also be given to seniors in local agencies which will be completed to fulfill the senior retreat requirement.

Presidential Service Award

The Senior Mission Trip does count toward the Presidential Service Award. However, you will not earn the minimum 100 hours needed receive this award. See the back of this handout for more information about the Presidential Service Award.

Wanting to improve your service portfolio? Remember, these projects DO NOT count toward MCHS service hours at the junior/senior level:

- Janitorial work at MCHS
- Babysitting
- Yard work or landscaping for neighbors/parents/grandparents
- Office work for your parents (unless they work fits one of the above categories)
